



Boma: Where will it take you?

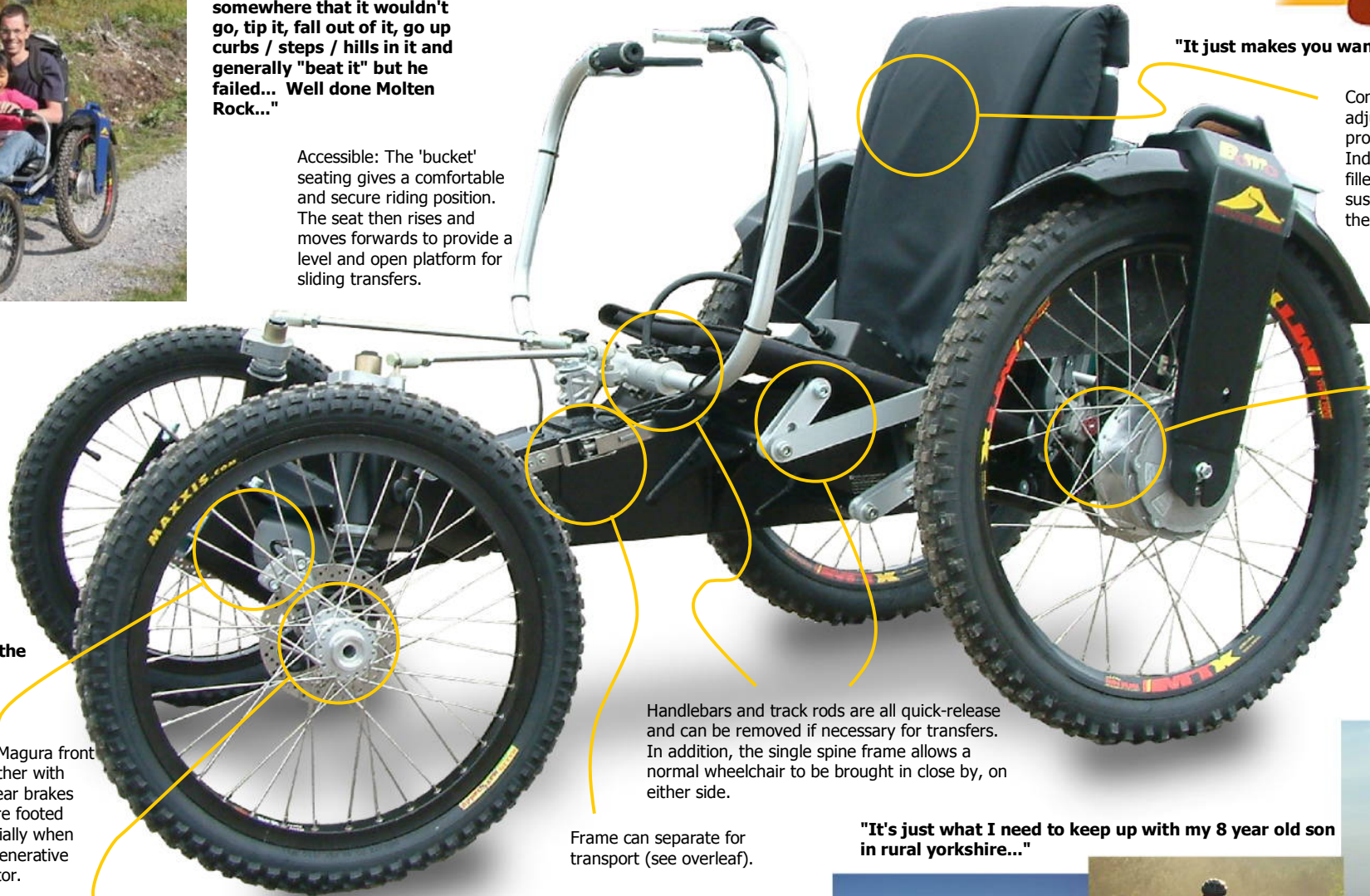


"My physio tried to find somewhere that it wouldn't go, tip it, fall out of it, go up curbs / steps / hills in it and generally "beat it" but he failed... Well done Molten Rock..."

Accessible: The 'bucket' seating gives a comfortable and secure riding position. The seat then rises and moves forwards to provide a level and open platform for sliding transfers.

"It just makes you want to drive over stuff..."

Comfortable: Padded, adjustable upholstery provides a comfortable seat. Independent, adjustable air filled Rock Shox rear suspension can be set-up to the riders preference.

Confidence: Balanced Magura front brakes for riding, together with electronic or manual rear brakes for parking provide sure footed stopping power, especially when combined with the regenerative braking from each motor.

Handlebars and track rods are all quick-release and can be removed if necessary for transfers. In addition, the single spine frame allows a normal wheelchair to be brought in close by, on either side.

Powerful: The two independent electric wheel motors have been specifically designed by Heinzmann for high torque, low speed operation.

Frame can separate for transport (see overleaf).

Independent Pro Shock coil suspension with hydraulic damping provides a smooth ride while the steering geometry removes shocks and provides lightweight steering. Minimal operator strength is required to turn the Boma.
