- The competition will be held under IPC Rules with DSE exemptions.
- The event is open to disabled swimmers only.
- Swimmers must be 10yrs as at 31 December 2010
- The One Start Rule will apply.
- **The Entry Fee will be £3.50 per swim (Entries cannot be processed without correct entry fees).**
Entry for Relay events – Free.

- **Closing date for Entries midnight on Monday 17th September 2010.**

- Event entries will be strictly Time Banded. – **The success of the competition depends on accurate swim times being submitted.**

- **ALL DIVE START CERTIFICATES TO BE SUBMITTED WITH ENTRY FORMS.**
- It will be swum with males and females swimming separately. Unless the lack of entries requires them to swim together.
- Team Relay events: 4 x 50m. Freestyle Team, 4 x 50m. Medley Team. Teams may enter as many Teams as they wish for the Relay events. The promoter reserves the right to reject relay teams if numbers of entries requires them to do so.
- Swimmers **must** report to the Competitors Stewards (situated at the deep end of the pool) at least four (4) heats before the start of their event. Swimmers will not be called or waited for if they are not present the event will run without them. If a swimmer misses his/her heat/event they will not be allowed to swim in another heat/event
- **Swimmers must swim in the lane that has been allocated to them unless requested to change by the Referee.**
- **Any swimmer who requires the use of the hoist or is a medical alert and needs an outside lane please inform us on the entry form**
- **Any swimmer who needs assistants in or out of the water must ensure they have enough support staff**
- Team Managers and Individual Entries (swimmers); please report/register upon your arrival to the registration clerks in the foyer. **REGISTRATION WILL BE FROM 14.00 to 14.30. A desk will be provided in the Foyer of The Quays**
- Within the guidelines of the ASA Child Protection Policy and the Promoters Club Members Protection Policy, anyone wishing to use a Video Camera and or a Wide Lens and or a Zoom Lens Camera during any part of this event, including the Warm up period, must complete the Photography Registration Form (enclosed), return with your entry or hand it to the staff at Registration Desk upon your arrival. Failure to do this will lead to the Camera operator being asked to leave the event.
- Team Managers and Individual Entries (swimmers) will receive start sheets at the beginning of the session.
- Further programmes will be available for supporters at the door a charge will be made for a programme a raffle will also be run
- **All withdrawals must be reported to registration desk no later than 14.30**
- **Any withdrawals will NOT be refunded.**
- The promoters have the right to refuse entries.
- The results will be placed on the SER web site upon completion of the competition.
- Lifeguard cover throughout the competition.
- Pool hoist is available, if required (please inform on entry form).
- Team Managers Support Staff are reminded there is to be no coaching from the pool deck behind the blocks, no walking up and down the pool deck.
- Starting devices are to be checked before the start of the competition.

POOL AND POOLSIDE SAFETY

- **FIRE EXITS** are clearly marked. Everyone attending must ensure that they familiarise themselves with these exits in case of any emergency. A copy of the Pools NOP's and EAP's will be available upon request from the Leisure Centre Reception Desk.
- Team Managers/Individual swimmers shall satisfy themselves that their swimmers/individuals are competent to the standard of the ASA Competitive Start Award. Any swimmer who is not competent must start from the poolside or in the water. In the event of a false start swimmers must execute a shallow racing dive. They must not topple in headfirst as this is dangerous.

- Team Managers please ensure you have enough team support on the pool deck the swimmers are your responsibility.

The depth of the pool:	Shallow end. 1.2m.
Deep end.	2m.
The width of the pool:	12.5m.
Length of Pool:	25m.

- **NO DIVING FROM THE SHALLOW END OF THE POOL WILL BE ALLOWED AT ANYTIME.**
- **The use of the Diving Pit and Fun Pool before, during or after the competition is not permitted.**
- Swimmers and spectators are reminded that property should not be left unattended at any time. DSE South East Region cannot accept liability for any loss or damage that may occur.
- Lockers are provided in the changing room please ensure you have change
- Any matter not covered above will be decided at the discretion of the DSE South East Region who also reserves the right to make any changes that may be considered necessary for the smooth running of the event.
