JOB PURPOSE

To be the main contact for the region regarding all Young Officials in the area and ensure that opportunities to take part in officiating are made easily accessible to all those that wish to participate. The Young Official Deployment Officer (YODO) will be required to work with the Young People Coordinator (YPC) to provide external opportunities to those who have already completed the award, whilst also working towards increasing the amount of qualified Young Officials by actively recruiting tutors where required.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

- To be the main contact in the region for the Young People Coordinator with regards to Young Officials.
- To maintain and grow the network of tutors in the region, and inform them of any opportunities to increase the workforce of Young Leaders.
- To promote the PLUS Programme and encourage Young Officials to be actively volunteering in their local areas. I.e. Schools, clubs etc.
- Work with Regional Associations to setup a network of opportunities for Young Officials to gain experience of officiating*.

*(Due to not being Grade IV qualified, the most talented Young Officials would be best suited in lower level volleyball, covering line judge/ Scoring roles. HOWEVER, they will not be qualified in these fields, and only the ability-confident Young Officials should be used)

Desirable Trait¹:

A P.E. Teacher or Level II Qualified coach	This would mean the YODO could also be a Tutor.
