A guided walk led by Deal based artist/curator Christine Gist to explore some of the architectural heritage of the South Foreland coast. An opportunity to visit and climb up the National Trust's South Foreland Lighthouse and continue on to St Margaret's Bay, the former home of Noel Coward and Ian Fleming. The walk will include a private visit to the award winning low carbon Pines Calyx™ with free entry to Pines Garden and St Margaret's Museum.

There will be an opportunity for refreshments at The Coastguard Pub, St. Margaret's bay or bring a packed lunch. Participants will return via the cliffs to the White Cliffs Visitor Centre.
