

Final draft of list of facilities, as at Monday 29 January 2007 5pm, being included in the cluster submissions for Pre Games Training Camps.

Stour Leisure Centre- this centre is currently going through a major expansion programme, (see next section).

Tenterden Leisure Centre- a sprung wooden floor sports hall (34x19x 7.5mt), fitness suite and general activity rooms.

Julie Rose Athletics Stadium- a 400mt 8 lane floodlit international standard athletics track stadium containing all the necessary field areas. This facility also has an indoor 60mt 6 lane training straight, long jump run up and landing sandpit and a training area/net cage for discus and shot. Underneath the training straight is a fitness suite with some equipment specifically designed for specialist athletics training. There are also rooms such as a dividable conference suite available for a multitude of uses. Beside the stadium is a floodlit multi use games area.

Ashford Hockey Pitch- floodlit sand dressed artificial grass hockey pitch surrounded by a cricket ground and five football pitches all available for use as training areas for the 2012 Games.

Chilham Park- set in 300 acres of parkland is the Chilham Equine Centre consisting of a 30x50mt soft track arena, a 40 jump cross-country course and on site accomodation for grooms.

Great Chart Golf Club- has constructed a two court floodlit Beach Volleyball area.

Dover Leisure Centre- a sprung wooden floor sports hall (32x28x12mts), a 25 mt swimming pool and teaching pool and a health and fitness suite.

Tides Leisure Centre- a sprung wooden floor sports hall (33x18x7.6mt), a 25mt swimming pool, an indoor Tennis Centre with 3 acrylic courts and a health and fitness suite.

Sandwich Sports and Leisure Centre- is on the site of Sandwich School, the centre has a semi sprung wooden floor (33x18x7.6mt), a health and fitness suite and general sports activity rooms.

Fowlmead Country Park- has been created from the redundant coalfield of Betteshanger Colliery and is now owned by SEEDA. The park contains three different bicycle road-racing circuits, a mountain bike area and a BMX track.

Deal Gymnastics Centre- This centre has a specialism in Womens Artistic Gymnastics and Sports Acrobatics. The centre is flexible to the requirements of a gymnast.

Dover Football Stadium- an enclosed stadium surrounded by 69 acres of undulating land available for mountain biking.

The Valley Leisure Centre- this is located on land of Pent Valley Technology College the sports facilities have been specially designed to take into account the fact that a considerable number of pupils are registered disabled. A sizeable proportion of the pupils are wheelchair users. The Sports Centre is a separate building consisting of a sprung wooden floor sports hall (34x19x7.6mt), sprung wooden floor dance studio for other general sporting related activities, an IFI accredited fitness suite, catering area and a radio station. It is the home of a Wheelchair basketball Club and a Sitting Volleyball Club with a specialist sitting volleyball floor.

Cheriton Road Recreation Ground- this land is 15 acres of playing fields and includes a floodlit sand filled artificial grass hockey pitch.

Southlands Leisure Centre- is sited on land at Southlands School, it has a semi sprung wooden floor sports hall (33x18x7.6mt) and a health and fitness suite.

Also, all school facilities in the cluster have extensive playing fields, but some schools have other facilities with separate changing rooms etc that include-

The Towers School- a semi sprung wooden floor sports hall (36x18x7.6mt), sprung wooden floor dance studio, a fitness suite, a sand filled artificial grass hockey pitch.

Christ Church School- a sprung vinyl floor sports hall (33x18x7.6mt) and general sports activity rooms. Adjacent to this is a new 3,800 sq mt floodlit multi use games area

Homewood School- a semi sprung wooden floor sports hall (34x28x7.6mt), a single basketball practise court, both halls are overlooked by a coach education room.

The North School- (a specialist Sports College) a semi sprung wooden floor sports hall (33x18x7.6mt).

Archers Court School- a floodlit sand filled artificial grass hockey pitch.

Astor School- a semi sprung wooden floor sports hall (33x17x6.5mt) and fitness suite.

Sir Roger Manwood School- a semi sprung wooden floor sports hall (33x18x6.5mt) and a 52x30mt sand filled artificial grass pitch.

Duke of York's Military School- (Boarding Independent) sprung wooden floor sports hall (34x19x7.6mt), weights and fitness room.

Brockhill Park School- a semi sprung wooden floor sports hall (34x18x7.6mt) and a sprung wooden floor dance studio (15x13mt) available as a general activity area.

Harvey Grammar School- (a specialist Sports College) a semi sprung wooden floor sports hall (34x18x7.5mt).

University of Kent at Canterbury (UKC)- the sports facilities that exist at the UKC include, two sports halls (37x35x9mt and 32x17x9mt respectively). Olympic standard weight training room 245sq mts containing Olympic free weights and platforms, as well as fitness equipment. 100sq mt CV room. General sports activity rooms with sprung floors. Outside areas consist of a sandfilled and 3rd generation artificial grass pitches, a floodlit tarmac area containing seven Tennis/Netball courts, 300 acres of playing fields serviced by a separate pavilion with changing and meeting rooms, 230 acres of land yet to be developed into sports areas.

Canterbury Polo Farm Sports Club- this club's facilities include two floodlit water based artificial grass hockey pitches and one floodlit sandbased artificial grass hockey pitch. A pavilion, with changing rooms and meeting rooms, can cater for a significant numbers of players, having hosted many tournaments. A tennis centre of three indoor and six floodlit outdoor courts.

Kingsmead Sports and Leisure Centre- sprung wooden floor sports hall (33x23x7.6mts), 33mt swimming pool, teaching pool and leisure pool, and a weights and fitness suite containing 83 stations.

Christ Church University- BASES accredited Sports Science Department with a sprung floor Gymnasium and weights equipment to provide support in physiology, psychology, biomechanics and nutrition, fitness and treatment rooms.

St Lawrence Cricket Ground- is the home for Kent Cricket Club, with approximately 10 acres of land.

Whitstable Seasalter- 50 acres of open land, available to be developed for sports of Archery, Mountain biking or BMX. This site is adjacent to the A229 Thanetway and Travel Lodge style accomodation.

Pier Sports Centre- semi sprung wooden sports hall (36x18x6.5mts) and a weights and fitness suite with 34 stations.

Canterbury Gymnastics Centre- this centre has a specialism in Rhythmic Gymnastics. The centre is flexible to the requirements of an individual gymnast.

Hartsdown Sports and Leisure Centre- sprung wooden floor 1530sq mt sports hall (10 courts) 7.6mts high, a 25mt swimming pool and teaching pool, and a weights and fitness suite with 32 stations.

Ramsgate Sports Centre- semi sprung wooden floor 918sq mts (6 courts) 6.5mts high, a weights and fitness suite with 43 stations.

Jackie Bakers Playing Fields- this 10 acre field is adjacent to the Marlowe Academy. It contains a floodlit sand filled artificial grass hockey pitch and ancillary buildings.

Margate Beach- has been one of the sites on the World Grand Prix Beach Volleyball Circuit.

Swallows Leisure Centre- sprung floor wooden 918sq mts sports hall 6.5mts high, a 25mt swimming pool and teaching pool, and a weights and fitness suite with 70 stations.

Sheppey Leisure Centre- semi sprung wooden floor sports hall (33x18x6.5mts), a 25mt swimming pool and teaching pool, and a 25 station weights and fitness suite.

Faversham Gymnastics Centre- this centre has a specialism in general Gymnastics. The centre is flexible for the requirements of an individual gymnast.

Sittingbourne Racetrack- is currently used for a number of sports activities. The track, is securely designed for Archery, or can be converted into a BMX track at little expense.

Callum Park Equestrian Centre- has three Olympic sized equestrian arenas.

Also, all schools in the cluster have extensive playing fields as well as other relevant sports facilities including-

Canterbury High School- sprung vinyl floor sports hall (34x19x7.5mt), weights and fitness suite with IFI equipment, and general activity rooms. A 2 court tennis dome. An 8 lane athletics track with all the usual field event areas. This school is the host facility for one of the two Sitting Volleyball floors in the county and consequently has a sitting volleyball club.

Herne Bay High School- semi sprung floor sports hall (33x18x7mt), fitness studio, sprung floor general activity room, sprung floor gymnasium, a performance and analysis studio and a floodlit sand filled artificial grass hockey pitch.

Whitstable Community College- semi sprung floor sports hall (38x30x7.5mt).

Ursuline College- semi sprung floor sports hall (30x30x6.5mt).

The Marlowe Academy- sprung wooden floor sports hall (34x19x7.6mt), floodlit 8 lane intermediate surfaced synthetic athletics track and field event areas.

Borden Grammar School- floodlit sand based artificial grass hockey pitch.

Fulston Manor School- semi sprung floor sports hall (32x17x7.5mt).

Queen Elizabeth's School- semi sprung floor sports hall (35x19x8mt).

Minster College- a semi sprung floor sports hall (35x20x7.5mt), a floodlit 3rd generation artificial grass pitch.

Westlands School- floodlit sand filled artificial grass hockey pitch.

Sittingbourne Community College- semi sprung wooden floor sports hall (33x18x6.5mt), two sprung floor gymnasiums and activity rooms.

Abbeey School- sprung wooden floor sports hall (34x19x7.6mt), two general activity halls and a weights and fitness studio.

Arcacia Hall- a sprung wooden floor sports hall (33x18x7.6mt), a 42 station weights and fitness suite.

Fairfield Pool- a 25mt swimming pool with 1mt and 3mt springboards and a teaching pool. The facility also has a 42 station weights and fitness suite.

Swanscombe Leisure Centre- a semi sprung wooden floor 3 court sports hall 486 sq mts and a 47 station weights and fitness suite.

Dartford Football Stadium- a 5,000 seater stadium recently constructed. This stadium is fully enclosed and is available for secure sports activities such as Archery. Adjacent to the stadium is also a new floodlit 3rd Generation artificial grass pitch.

Dartford Dojo- this newly constructed facility is occupied by Dartford Judo Club. It has a two mat hall, a weights and fitness suite geared specifically to the needs of Judo players and changing facilities etc.

Arrow Riding School for Disabled- is a specialist facility geared to the needs of disabled riders. The staff have special experience and qualities to assist with disabled person's needs. The school has all the necessary equipment, land and facilities to aid and assist riders who are disabled.

Central Park Arena- is a floodlit 8 lane athletics track with all usual field event areas, changing rooms etc.

Stone Lodge- a large area of open playing field land that is suited to the needs of sports requiring such a large space such as Archery.

Goals Soccer Centre- a soccer centre with 10x 5 a side and 1x 7 a side 3rd generation pitches.

Cascades Leisure Centre- a sprung wooden floor sports hall 918 sq mts (6 courts), a 25mt swimming pool and a health and fitness suite.

Legend Sports Club- 2 indoor artificial grass tennis courts.

Cygnets Leisure Centre- a sprung wooden floor sports hall (33x18x7.6mt), a 25mt swimming pool, a separate diving pool with a 1mt springboard and a weights and fitness suite with 75 stations.

Guru Nanak Sports Centre- a centre owned and managed by the Sikh community, it has a small 180 sq mt sports hall and a fitness suite with 12 stations.

Meopham Leisure Centre- a sprung wooden floor sports hall (33x18x7.6mt) and a 38 station weights and fitness suite on the site of Meopham School (see below).

Northfleet Sports and Leisure Centre- a semi sprung wooden floor sports hall (33x18x6.5mt).

Gravesend Football Stadium- a totally enclosed stadium for outside sports activities that need a secure environment such as Archery.

The Meapa Gymnastics Centre- This centre has a specialism in Womens Artistic Gymnastics. The centre is flexible to the requirements of a gymnast.

Gravesend Artificial Grass Hockey Pitch- a floodlit sand filled artificial grass hockey pitch on land adjacent to Gravesend Grammar School for Boys.

Also, all schools in the cluster have extensive playing fields as well as other relevant sports facilities including-

Swan Valley Community School- (a specialist Sports College) a sports hall (33x18x7.6mt), a floodlit sand based artificial grass hockey pitch and weights and fitness suite.

Dartford Grammar School- this school's sports facility is totally separate from the other school buildings. Called the Becket Centre, it has a sprung wooden floor sports hall (33x18x7.6mt), a 28 station weights and fitness suite and general sports activity rooms.

Axton Chase School- this school has recently been successful with obtaining suitable funds for it to be completely rebuilt. Please see next script box for details.

Meopham School- (a specialist Sports College).

Cobham Hall School- (a Boarding Independent School) a sprung wooden floor sports hall 1221 sq mts, a 25mt swimming pool and a fitness suite with 12 stations.

Maidstone Leisure Centre- a sprung wooden floor sports hall (32x26x8mts), weights fitness and health suite, general activity rooms, 25mt pool with a separate diving pool (containing a 5mt platform, 1 x 3mt springboard, and 2 x 1mt springboards, as well as a 'dry side training' springboard in the sports hall), catering, changing rooms etc.

Mote Park- 450 acres of land available for Archery.

Astor Sports & Leisure Complex- semi sprung wooden floor sports hall (42x18x7mts), weights and fitness suite, squash courts (managed by Astor of Hever School a specialist Sports College).

Cobham Manor Riding Centre- equestrian centre containing two rings (20x40mts and 40x60mts), an indoor hall (20x40mts), 60 acres of land used for cross country, on site accomodation for grooms and catering.

Pegasus Gymnastics Centre- training centre for women's and men's artistic gymnastics. The centre is flexible for the requirements of an individual gymnast.

Mereworth Equine Veterinary Surgery- is renowned as one of the best in the country.

Also, all schools in the cluster have extensive playing fields and the following have other relevant sports facilities;

Oldborough Manor School- semi sprung wooden floor sports hall (33x18x7mts).

Cornwallis School- semi sprung wooden floor sports hall (36x18x9.5mts).

Maidstone Boys Grammar School- semi sprung wooden floor sports hall (32x17x8mts).

Senacre School- semi sprung wooden floor sports hall (35x18x6.5mts).

Swadelands School- (a specialist Sports College) semi sprung wooden floor sports hall (32x17x7.5mts).

St Simon Stock School- semi sprung wooden floor sports hall (33x18x6.5mts).

Sutton Valance School- (Boarding Independent School) sprung wooden floor sports hall (45x21x9mts) a floodlit sand filled artificial grass hockey pitch.

Jumpers Rebound Centre: A purpose-built international trampoline centre. The largest in Europe with 15 trampolines to international federation standard plus full support facilities.

Holcombe Hockey Club: One of Britain's largest hockey clubs, playing in the National league division one. A latest technology synthetic turf pitch which has achieved Global accreditation from the FIH (International Hockey Federation) – the first of its kind outside Australia - which was laid in summer 2006. This is complemented by a second fully-equipped synthetic sand-dressed turf pitch and a wide range of ancillary facilities in the adjoining clubhouse.

Gillingham Football Club: A professional Football League club currently in League One with a 10-seater stadium and full ancillary facilities.

Howard Table Tennis Centre: A purpose-built table tennis centre opened in 2005. It has a 22m x 18m playing area which can accommodate six tables at ETTA Grade 3 or up to four tables at international standard Grade 1. It meets all modern requirements including ancillary changing and rest/relaxation areas.

Medway Badminton Association: A purpose-built badminton centre comprising four courts with Taraflex surface over sprung wooden floor plus ancillary catering, changing and rest/relaxation areas.

Black Lion Leisure Centre: Medway's flagship leisure centre with 35m x 33m sports hall, health and fitness suite, 25m swimming pool, squash courts and wide range of ancillary facilities.

Universities at Medway campus: Opened in 2005, a unique campus shared by three universities, aiming to cater for 10,000 students. Will be used as a base for cycling as well as accommodation, catering and ancillary facilities for all teams using Medway as pre-Games training camp

Sevenoaks Sports and Leisure Centre- a sprung wooden floor sports hall (33x18x7.5mt), 25 mt swimming pool and teaching pool, weights and fitness suite, health studio general activity rooms, changing rooms etc.

Whiteoak Sports and Leisure Centre- a sprung wooden floor sports hall (37x20x7.1mt), 33mt swimming pool and general activity rooms.

Sevenoaks Hockey Pitch- a floodlit sand dressed artificial grass hockey pitch.

Edenbridge Leisure Centre- a sprung wooden floor sports hall (30x17x6.5mt) 25 mt swimming pool and teaching pool, weights and fitness suite, health suite, general activity rooms, changing rooms etc and a floodlit sand based artificial grass hockey pitch.

Penshurst Off Road Cycle Circuit- 46 acres of woodland containing mountain biking tracks, down hill slopes and jumps. A BMX track.

Brands Hatch Racing Circuit- This circuit is used for motor car, motor bike, truck racing and cycle races it has in the past been the venue for the British Grand Prix. The cycle circuit is 1.6 miles long.

Tonbridge Angel Centre- a sprung wooden floor sports hall 30mts square, weights and fitness room, and general activity rooms.

Larkfield Leisure Centre- a sprung wooden floor sports hall 30mts square, 25mt swimming pool, separate leisure pool and separate teaching pool, weights and fitness room and health suite.

Buckmore Park Sports Centre- a sprung wooden floor sports hall (45x25x9.5mt), 25mt swimming pool, rifle range, archery range, weights and fitness suite, camping site and on site bedroom accommodation, an administration block containing a large number of meeting rooms and offices.

Tonbridge Racecourse Sports Ground- This ground is 69 acres in the middle of Tonbridge town. It is the home for a number of clubs of different sports such as Archery, Football and Rugby.

Tunbridge Wells Sports Centre- two sprung wooden floor sports halls (each 34x19x7.1mt), 25 mt swimming pool, separate diving pool 3mt deep with a five metre diving platform, two 3mt spring boards and four 1mt spring boards, two 1mt diving boards are located in one of the sports halls for 'dry side' training, an indoor tennis centre with four courts, a weights and fitness suite and health & therapy rooms.

The Hop Farm Country Park- Is the site where many 'outdoor' sports events take place including junior football talent identification.

Weald Sports Centre- a sprung wooden floor sports hall (33x18x7.5mt), 25mt swimming pool weights and fitness suite and general activity rooms.

Putlands Sports Centre- a sprung wooden sports hall (34x19x7.1mt) and general activity rooms.

Nevill Sports Ground- 80 acres of sports ground, the home of Tunbridge Wells Cricket Club and used by Kent Cricket Club to play matches each year. Can be used for archery.

Bewl Water Reservoir- 700 acres of water currently used for sheltered sailing, rowing and canoeing. The reservoir has 13 miles circumference of mountain biking round the outside. The water area currently has a 1500mt straight rowing/canoeing line. (see also Accommodation section).

Bedgebury Pinetum- the 800hectare National Pinetum at Bedgebury contains a 13k single-track mountain bike trail, a 9k 'family' cycle trail and a 'Free Ride' skills area.

All school facilities in the cluster area have extensive playing fields, some schools have other facilities that include-

Sevenoaks School- a sprung wooden floor sports hall (37x34x7.6mt), weights and fitness room, general activity rooms, indoor tennis centre containing three courts, 25mt indoor swimming pool, 400mt 6 lane athletics track and field event areas. The school is the Kent Centre of Excellence for Basketball.

Wilderness School- a semi sprung wooden floor sports hall (34x18x6.5mt), floodlit sand dressed artificial grass hockey pitch.

Swanley School- a semi sprung wooden floor sports hall (33x18x6.5mt), floodlit sand filled artificial grass hockey pitch.

Valence School-a special disability school (see Accomodation section below).

Tonbridge School- a sprung wooden floor sports hall (34x34x7.5mt), a floodlit water based artificial grass hockey pitch, two sand based artificial grass pitches 400mt 8 lane athletics track and field event areas, used by Dame Kelly Holmes, a small bore shooting range and armoury, sports hall and 25mt swimming pool.

Hayesbrook School- a semi sprung wooden floor sports hall (34x19x6.5mt).

Aylesford School- a semi sprung wooden floor sports hall (34x19x6.5mt).

The Malling School- a semi sprung wooden floor sports hall (34x18x7mt).

Hugh Christie School- a semi sprung wooden floor sports hall (33x18x7mt).

Mascalls School- a sprung wooden floor sports hall (33x18x6.5mt).

Cranbrook School- a sprung wooden floor sports hall (38x19x7.5mt), floodlit sand filled artificial grass hockey pitch.

Angley School- a solid concrete floor sports hall (36x19x8mt).

Tunbridge Wells High School- a semi sprung wooden floor sports hall (34x19x6.5mt), fitness room and general activity room.
