



Criteria for Kent TRUST FOR YOUTH SPORT

to ORGANISATIONS/CLUBS

1. Your application will be assessed by the panel taking into account input from the governing body of your sport, where applicable, and the panel's judgement will be final. There will be 4 deadlines a year, after which the panel will meet. Please ensure you apply well in advance of when you require support, indicating any dates for events or training wherever possible.
2. The fund is small in scale, with limited amounts available 4 times a year and therefore we must warn applicants that it may not be possible to fulfil all requests.
3. Applications can be for any sport but will only be considered from those organisations applying from within their county governing body of sport geographical boundaries.
4. Maximum grant available is £1000.00 (dependent on funds available and number of applications).

The fund is for:

- Helping clubs in financial need to meet the costs of purchasing kit or equipment
- Contributing to the costs of sports development programmes
- Funding sports events

5. Organisations can only apply for one grant in any one year.
6. Funding cannot be retrospectively awarded for events and training which has already taken place or equipment costs already incurred.
7. There must be a demonstrable financial need. Funding will not be given or may be reduced if there is a significant amount of financial support from another source.
8. Recipients will need to provide a short report and photos within one month of the event/project taking place.

Conditions

- National governing bodies of sport may be consulted to assist in the prioritisation of applications in the event that several applications are made by organisations / clubs from the same sport.
- As a recipient of a grant you will be required to promote the fact that you have been supported by the Kent Trust for Youth Sport
- The Kent Trust for Youth Sport reserve the right to withdraw or re-claim part or all of an award, if any information provided is found to be inaccurate or the award is not used for the purposes for which it was given.
