**THE BRITISH TIME TRIAL CHAMPIONSHIPS 2010.
Factoring results**

The British BCT and H Time Trial Championships will be open to all competitors with the prefix GBR on their Licence and have a Para Category.

The Championships will be decided by factoring based upon the norms created for the World Para Cycling Road Championships held in Canada.

The Norms are the target KPH for each category. These are published by the UCI and are:-

The method of deciding the Championships will be by calculating each competitors KPH as completed on Sunday 5th September and by making a percentile comparison against the competitors classification target time determining a points score. If a competitor achieves a faster average KPH than the target, then the score will be higher than 100, if a slower KPH then the score will be less than 100.

In both Championships the rider with the highest score will be awarded the Championship and the title National Paracycling Time Trial Champion.

Example

A BVI Male competitor will have the target KPH of 45.67. If he achieves a time of 36 mins 23 secs this will equal an average kph for the race of 38.391kph. The Points scored will be 83.514.

A C5 Female competitor records a time of 22 mins 13 secs. This equal 41.914 kph. Against a target of 39.40 kph this competitor achieves 106.382 points.
